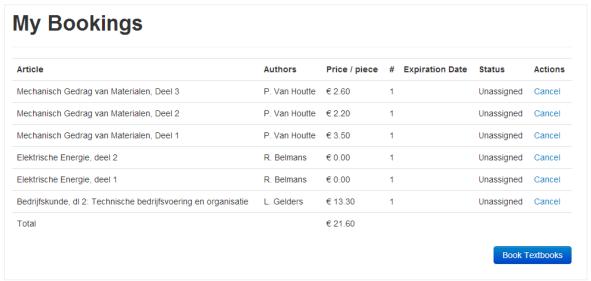
## How to order books

- 1. Go to **vtk.be** and **log in**.
- 2. Click the **profile button** (the little head top right), then **My Bookings**.



3. Here you can see the books you've ordered. **Assigned** means you can go get them at Cudi, **Unassigned** means you'll have to wait until they're stocked.



4. Click Book Textbooks.

5. Enter a 1 in the boxes next to the books you want to order.

The final column shows how many copies you've already ordered.

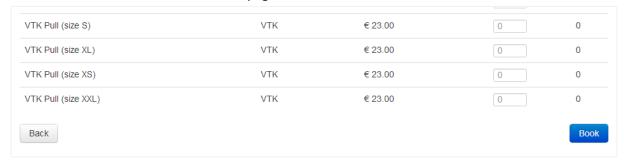
When the line is highlighted in green, you've already been to CuDi and got the book.

- c. The professor doesn't publish his books and/or notes at CuDi. To be sure, ask him/her. If the notes are put online on Toledo, you can come print them at CuDi.
